Jacob Katz (Hebrew: יעקב קאץ) (born 15 November 1904 in Magyargencs, Hungary, died 20 May 1998 in Israel) was a Jewish historian and educator. Katz, who lived at that time in Tel Aviv and worked as a lecturer in a College of Jewish Studies, was the author of *Exclusiveness and Tolerance: Studies in Jewish-Gentile Relations in Medieval and Modern Times*. The book is available in several formats: paperback (\$2.33), hardcover, and e-book. It is also available in a digital format on Google Books. The book is a collection of essays that explore the relationship between Jews and non-Jews in the Middle Ages and the modern period. Katz argues that the Jewish community in the Middle Ages was not as isolated as is often portrayed, and that there was a significant degree of interaction and exchange between Jews and non-Jews. He also discusses the role of the Jewish community in the development of modern Jewish identity and the rise of anti-Semitism in the modern period.
